

IQAC REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2006-07

Part-A: Plan of Action

Education is dynamic and stands for comprehensive development of personality of the students. Quality Education is a continuous process that demands unstinted commitment and our college actively plans for various curricular, co-curricular and extra curricular activities for the totality of learner oriented education. The college strongly believes and inculcates not only subject related skills but also other life skills which are very prime in the globalised competitive world. The college designs the students to fit into the multiple demands and requirements of the latest society. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has chalked out the following plan of action for the academic year 2006-07.

- a) To organize national seminars with the assistance of UGC.
- b) To provide additional inputs to the students through extension lectures.
- c) To organize field trips to the students to have exposure to outside world.
- d) To establish an English language lab to improve the Communicative competence of students.
- e) To organize symposia to develop the interactive skills of the students and to update their knowledge.
- f) To evaluate the performance of the students and to get feedback from them to improve the academic standards.
- g) To organize the activities of the alumni associations on a regular basis to provide guidance to the present students.

- h) To organize inter-collegiate events to develop the leadership qualities and interactive skills of the students.
- i) To undertake social awareness programmes by NSS units of the college.
- j) To improve the infrastructural facilities in the college.
- k) To encourage the faculty to take up Minor Research Projects.
- l) To initiate steps for campus placement programmes on a regular basis.
- m) To introduce new courses at P.G. level to meet the growing demand of the day.

Part- B:

1. Activities undertaken:

In order to achieve the objectives spelled out in the Annual Action Plan, the following activities are undertaken during the academic year 2006-07.

- 32 Extension lectures by various departments.
- One National Seminar
- Inter class and intra class debates and group discussions.
- Two symposiums and one workshop
- Two study tours.
- Development of infrastructural facilities.
- Introduction of job oriented and need based courses.
- Initiation of quality measures.
- Introduction of modern methods of teaching and learning.
- Construction of language laboratory.
- Research programmes and field surveys.
- Regular interactive sessions.
- NSS, Games & Sports, NCC and Cultural activities.

2. New Academic programmes initiated at UG and PG levels.

During the academic year 2005-06 proposals were submitted to introduce B.A(Literature) at UG level and M.Sc (Chemistry) and M.Sc (Physics) at PG level. The University accorded permission and courses have been introduced with an intake of 44 in B.A (Literature) and 33 each in two P.G courses. During 2006-07, new proposals have been submitted

to AICTE, Southern Regional Office, Chennai for starting MBA additional section and MCA from the academic year 2007-08, keeping in view the importance and relevance of I.T. Sector. We are hopeful of getting permission to these two courses and infrastructure is being developed to meet the requirements of AICTE.

3. **Innovation in curricular design and Transaction:**

The curriculum for UG courses is developed by State Council of Higher Education, Hyderabad and implemented by the Universities, whereas the PG curriculum is developed by Universities only. The Board of Studies will formulate the syllabus and on the approval of Executive Council, it is implemented by all colleges. Most of our staff members are members on the Board of Studies of different faculties. The teaching faculty took active role in the departmental meetings in designing the syllabi of Biotechnology, Commerce and other subjects.

4. **Inter-disciplinary programmes:**

Inter-disciplinary programmes have been organized to improve the knowledge, analytical ability and cognitive skills of the students. The programmes undertaken include:

- One-day symposium on Health Education organized by the Department of Commerce.
- Bio-statistics classes of B.Sc. I year (Biotechnology) handled by Dr.M. Yadagiri, Lecturer in Commerce.
- Career guidance and planning classes conducted for Arts students by Dr. Rudra Saibaba, Reader in Commerce.

- Programmes on Tissue Culture, Microbiology, PCR techniques, Protoplast fusion technique, UV spectro-photometer were undertaken by the Department of Botany and Biotechnology.
- An inter-disciplinary programme on crystallography, for the benefit of Biology and Chemistry students were organized by the Department of Physics.

5) **Examination Reforms implemented:**

The college continued the examination system introduced from the academic year 2005-06. Quarterly, Half-yearly, Pre-final examinations were conducted apart from the regular slip tests. The valued answer scripts were discussed in the classes and the doubts were clarified. A list of the candidates who did not take up the examinations were displayed on the noticed board and letters were also sent to the parents informing the performance of the students in the examination. Staff members direct interaction with students and their parents has improved the performance in the subsequent examinations. Question Banks were prepared by the staff members and supplied to students to prepare well for the University examination. Model Practical examinations were also organized to boost the confidence level of students. The Question Banks for practical examinations prescribed by Kakatiya University have been taken up by all the departments and the students are well trained for the year end examination.

II) **Symposium on Emerging Trends in Commerce Education:**

The Lal Bahadur College Commerce Alumni Society has organized a symposium on “Emerging Trends in Commerce Education” in memory of Late Dr. M.N. Ramesh Kumar, on 24th January 2007. The Panel Speakers were Sri D. Kumaraswamy, President, Chamber of Commerce, Sri Manikya Prasad, President, Tax Bar Association and Prof.G. Narasimha Murthy, Principal, University P.G. College, Subedari, Warangal. The panel speakers stressed the importance of the growing demand for Commerce Education. The profession of accountancy is providing more employment opportunities. The speakers advised the students to improve their computer skills, communication skills, interpersonal skills, behaviour skills and presentation skills. Courses like Foreign Trade, International banking, Information Technology, Rural Marketing, Retail Marketing, Pharma Management, CRM, Communications Management, Accounting packages provide wide opportunities to the commerce students. 21. **Improvement in the Library Services:**

As a part of ongoing advancement facilities in libraries, the college became a member of DELNET, an Internet service organization. It facilitates major resource sharing library network in South Asia covering a wide spectrum of member – libraries and connecting more than 1000 libraries in many states of India and Six Overseas Countries.

Delnet is committed to pool the information about resources scattered in the libraries in the country and consolidate information

through union catalogues, union lists and other databases. Steps have been initiated to purchase soul software with internet facility from Information and Library Network Centre, an autonomous center of UGC. Arrangements are made to send the librarian, for training in installation and operation of 'soul' at inflibnet center, Ahmedabad. The library is provided with internet facility and staff and students can download the required information from journals, magazines and books.

22. **New Books and Journals subscribed and their value:**

At P.G. Centre of our college, 600 volumes have been purchased worth Rs.2,10,370 during the year 2006-07 and total number of volumes comes to 6,068 and the total value is Rs.11,33,641.

At U.G. college, 688 volumes have been added at a cost of Rs.2,87,976. The college is subscribing about 60 journals and magazines and 9 dailies at a cost of Rs.1,17,363. The reading rooms of P.G and U.G. Blocks are well furnished and on an average the readership per day is 250 to 300 students. 23. **Assessment of Teachers and action taken on the student Feedback.**

A structured questionnaire has been served on the students to get feedback about every lecturer. The responses were tabulated by the Academic programmes committee and performance of every teacher is evaluated on the basis of feedback given by the students. Accordingly, lecturers were invited by the Principal and discussed the feedback results individually. The feedback received from the students is highly satisfactory (with regard to all the staff members). For newly appointed lecturers, an orientation programme is organized to improve their teaching skills to the satisfaction of students.

24. **Unit Cost of Education:**

The unit cost of education at U.G. level is Rs.1092 and at P.G. level is Rs.2586.

25. **Computerisation of Administration, process of Admissions & Examination results:**

A) **Computerisation of Administration:**

The administration is fully computerized. Every section is provided with a system and all the systems are connected through LAN. A package is designed for office automation to carryout work pertaining to admission process, accounts, salary bills, examination system etc.

B) **Process of Admissions:**

For all the P.G. courses, the admission process is undertaken by the Director of Admissions, Kakatiya University, Warangal.

The Management quota seats are filled up by the management as per the guidelines given by AICTE and Kakatiya University. For U.G. courses, the rules and regulations of Commissioner of Collegiate Education, Govt. of A.P. are followed in admitting the students to different courses. The rules of reservation are strictly followed. The application forms received for different courses are computerized and on the last day of closure of receiving application forms, medium wise merit order list is prepared for every course. The lists are handed over to the Admission Committees and the lists of the selected candidates are displayed on the notice board. If any seats are unfilled, on the last day of closure of admissions, spot selections are made from among the applicants attending the final phase of selection. Thus transparency is maintained in the admissions to various courses.

26. **Increase in Infrastructural Facilities:**

Department of Biotechnology is fully equipped with necessary instruments, chemicals and glassware, furniture etc. During 2006-07, it procured cold centrifuge, Micro oven, Microscopes, Scanner, Colour Printer, Fax-cum-Xerox unit for the computer.

27. **Technology Upgradation:**

The college has installed the broad band connection from BSNL as service provider. Broad band connection is providing a speed of 256 KPbs to achieve web pages on internet with which students are comfortable to use the internet facilities in the campus. All the systems in the computer laboratory are provided with UPS units to facilitate the students to save the files and backup the data when the power goes off.

The computer lab is provided with a LCD projector and a wall mounted screen and overhead projector for effective teaching. Dr.M. Dharmender Rao, Coordinator of Biotechnology course has attended 5 workshops conducted by the Department of Biotechnology, Kakatiya University for college teachers. He learnt new techniques and new protocols were developed for various experiments which are adopted in our college.

The institution has 30 P-III systems with internet connections. But to cope up with the technology changes, the management has decided to go for P-IV systems in the year 2006-07. In that process, the management has purchased 30 more systems with new dimensions in the technology. Department of Botany procured sophisticated equipment

which enables the students to know new technologies in the field. The equipment include Rotary Incubator, a Colony Counter, a Haemocytometer, a Tissue Homogenizer and a Micro Centrifuge.

28. **Computer and Internet access:**

All the departments of the college are connected with internet facility. The software programmes were also updated from time to time. Computer awareness programme is taken up for the new staff members.

Internet facility is provided to teachers and students during college working hours at free of cost. Each department possess a computer with internet connection which is used by the teaching staff. Students are allowed to download the documents related to their subjects and have a printout in the computer center. Students also develop project work in the computer center.

29. **Financial Aid to students:**

Financial aid is provided to the students of P.G. courses by the Government of A.P. through Social Welfare and Tribal Welfare Department. For the academic year 2006-07, 35 SC, 11 ST and 95 BC students received the assistance from the Government. In U.G. courses 508 ST, 383 SC and 1125 BC students received the aid from the Government.

Apart from the financial aid received from the different departments of government, the staff members have identified the poorest of poor students and paid the tuition fee. The Commerce Alumni Society has donated Rs.24,000 towards the tuition fee of 14 poor students of B.Com. Commerce Alumni and Poultry Science Alumni Societies have

created corpus fund and made Fixed Deposits to give financial assistance to poor students with the interest accrued on it.

The management has been giving financial assistance of Rs.900 to each of the Biotechnology student of final year to go for 'On Job Training' since 4 years. For developing Communication Skills, the management has entered into an agreement with JKC with a fees of Rs.50,000 for the course.

30. **Activities and support from the Alumni Association:**

I) **The Commerce Alumni Society's activities are as follows:**

The Commerce Alumni Society has given financial assistance of Rs.24,000 to 14 poor students. It organized a workshop on 'Contemporary Issues in Commerce and Management' on 25-01-2007. It also honoured Ms. Ramya, KU B.Com Second Rank holder and girls topper with a Gold Medal, on the eve of college day celebration. Alumni office bearers have also taken initiative to invite Mofai Consultants for a placement programme in the college. The Alumni Association is also registered as Lal Bahadur College Commerce Alumni Society with Registrar of Societies, Warangal, vide Registered No.410/2006 Society's Website is created to give the details of alumni Members.

II) **The Poultry Science Alumni Society's activities are given below:**

It collected donations from its members and others and financial assistance is offered to poor Poultry students. It provided

placement opportunities to the outgoing students. Various farms, poultry farmers and Alumni have donated an amount of Rs.1.00 lakh which is made Fixed Deposit with State Bank of Hyderabad for 500 days on 06-03-2007. The interest accrued on this deposit will be utilized to give scholarships to the students.

III) In P.G. centre, a registered alumni association is in existence with a title Renaissance Alumni Association. Every year on friendship day or the first sunday of August month, alumni members meet in the college premises. The alumni meet for 2006-07 promised to provide summer placement for project works, organize campus interviews and arrange extension lectures. The Alumni is very strong and every year it is offering placement to the outgoing students.

31. **Activities and support from the Parent – Teacher Association:**

The parents meet has been organized on 11-02-2007 in the college auditorium. The interaction of staff with the parents has resulted in a number of improvements in academic programmes which are likely to be implemented from the academic year 2007-08. The suggestions offered by the parents are:

- Arranging extra classes for the benefit of the academically weak students in the evening hours.
- Changing the college timings from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. to suit the requirements of rural students.
- To provide Hostel accommodation for boys and girls.

- Keeping open the library from 10.00 a.m. to 8.00 p.m. every day.
- Providing the schedule of extra and co-curricular activities in advance.
- Establishing language laboratory to improve the Communication Skills.
- Taking up English Fluency Development course in summer vacation.
- Giving updated knowledge on computer science and its applications.
- Informing periodically the performance of the students in exams.

All these suggestions offered by the parents have been discussed with staff members and also brought to the notice of the Governing Body Members of the college. The Management advised the Principal to implement most of the suggestions offered by parents.

32. **Health Services:**

The college is running a health clinic in the campus. Dr. Srinivas, Physician, the alumni of the college and other doctors have been invited to ensure a general checkup of the students.

In P.G.
